### **H. Keith Wagner Exhibits at *Vintage Inspired Lifestyle Marketplace* in August**

Burlington, VT: (July 24, 2013) Vintage Inspired Lifestyle Marketplace on Flynn Avenue in Burlington is pleased to announce an exhibition of paintings from Vermont landscape architect and artist H. Keith Wagner entitled *Tar Paper Series*, August 2<sup>nd</sup> through the 25th. There will be an opening reception on First Friday, August 2nd; from 5 to 8pm. *Tar Paper Series* is a collection of paintings created on common roofing tar paper, exploring the power of texture and its importance on our memory. The tar paper has an inherent textural quality and is used as a basis for a series of abstract landscapes. Vintage Inspired, A vibrant new marketplace for antique dealers, artists and craftspeople, is located at 180 Flynn Avenue, and is open Monday through Saturday from 10am to 5pm and Sunday from 12pm to 4pm.

Landscape architect, artist and founding partner of Wagner Hodgson Landscape Architecture, Keith received a Bachelor of Landscape Architecture from ESF - Syracuse University in 1985. The following years were spent in Boston working as a lead designer with William Pressley & Associates where he played an important role in the design of a broad range of institutional and corporate projects. Keith's established his own practice in 1987 in Burlington, Vermont. Since that time the office has grown into a diverse practice with a formidable reputation for establishing a strong sculptural dialogue between buildings and landscape. As an artist, Keith was inspired by the agrarian landscape of his childhood, his father's passion for industrial design and fabrication, and a life-long love of minimalism. Keith began using his artistic expressions as a release from the conventions of my design practice, exploring abstract painting, two-dimensional collages and metal assemblage as part of the design process for specific projects. Keith is active as a visiting professor at ESF - Syracuse University, a design juror, frequent lecturer, and has been widely published. Wagner Hodgson Landscape Architecture (formerly H. Keith Wagner Partnership) has received numerous commendations and awards for institutional, corporate, public and residential landscape design from the American Society of Landscape Architects, the American Institute of Architects and the Vermont Planning Association. Keith's sculpture and paintings have been shown in various
