Artist Ginny Joyner's Watercolors at Vintage Inspired In August

Burlington, VT: (July 27, 2015) Vintage Inspired Lifestyle Marketplace on Flynn Avenue in Burlington is pleased to announce an exhibition of watercolors, giclee prints and cards entitled *Inspired by Vintage*, by Vermont artist Ginny Joyner. The exhibition opens with a reception on Friday, August 7th from 5:00pm to 7:00pm, and runs through August 31st. Vintage Inspired, A vibrant marketplace for antique dealers, artists and craftspeople, is located at 180 Flynn Avenue, and is open Monday through Saturday from 10am to 5pm and Sunday from 12pm to 4pm.

Ginny Joyner's *Inspired by Vintage* brings original watercolors, giclee prints & cards of quirky objet d'art, from shoes to teapots to sushi, in antique handpainted frames to Vintage Inspired in August.

Ginny Joyner began her career as an artist at a very early age, decorating her parent's furniture and walls with her lively crayon drawings. She was told that paper was a more acceptable surface on which to create pictures and has since been pleased to find that people enjoy her work. Born in Adelaide Australia, she has lived in Japan and many states along the Eastern Seaboard, from Florida to Massachusetts, settling in Vermont in 1989.

Ginny graduated from the Rhode Island School of Design in 1986 with a BFA in Illustration. She has been a freelance illustrator for over 30 years with clients including Harper Collins Publishers, The W.S. Badger Co., Gardener's Supply, Sleeping Bear Press, Garlic Press and The Vermont Teddy Bear Co., among many others.

Her children's book, *M is for Maple Syrup, A Vermont Alphabet*, is part of the State-by-State series published by Sleeping Bear Press. She is a member of the Vermont Watercolor Society and teaches watercolor classes to beginners and advanced students through programs in Colchester and Hinesburg, VT as well as in her home studio at historic Fort Ethan Allen. She is represented by The Three Pears Gallery in Dorset, VT. She lives with her husband, folk painter

Howard Riley, her very talented daughter, Lucie Adelaide and their cute but ferocious Scottie dog, Ringo.
